RETURN TO SCHOOL INFORMATION



Frequent hand washing is encouraged, with breaks for scheduled handwashing at elementary level. Hand sanitizer is recommended to bring from home.



BUSES WILL BE CLEANED/DISINFECTED AFTER MORNING AND AFTERNOON ROUTES.



STUDENTS ARE DISCOURAGED FROM SHARING BOOKS, MATERIALS, SUPPLIES, OR EQUIPMENT, INCLUDING DEVICES AND EQUIPMENT USED FOR ATHLETICS/PE.

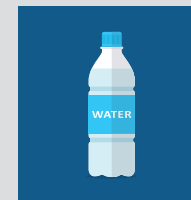
When feasible by school, social-distancing practices will be in place. Meals may be served in classrooms, lunch periods and playground time may be staggered and parent/school meetings/events may be held virtually or in a blended fashion when possible.



Periodic screening, including random temperature checks, will be conducted. Students and staff with COVID-19 symptoms or a temperature of 100.4+ will be isolated immediately and sent home. All students and employees must stay home if they have COVID-19 symptoms, tested positive, or had prolonged close contact with a person with COVID-19.



CLEANING/DISINFECTING OF BUILDINGS, SURFACES, AND HIGH-TOUCH OBJECTS WILL BE DONE MORE FREQUENTLY. VENTILATION SYSTEMS WILL BE MONITORED FOR PROPER OPERATION.



STUDENTS WILL BE ENCOURAGED TO BRING WATER FROM HOME.



Students and staff are expected to wear face coverings when physical distancing is not possible indoors.

Carroll County Schools is working closely with the Department of Public Health, local emergency management and other local officials for common sense return to school practices. If a student and/or staff member becomes sick, health department guidelines will be followed for return to school/work.
