What does this mean? **Stay home!** And **only leave when necessary** as outlined below.



Who and Where?

Residents of City of
Carrollton / Carroll County

NO CURFEW IN PLACE



No Gatherings

Of any size, public or private
outside of the home



When is this Effective?

Now until further notice



Social Distance from Others

Stay at least 6 feet away from
others - even outside

ONLY LEAVE TO:



Get essential items: food, supplies,
household items, prescriptions, take-
out orders.



Seek medical care: seeing a doctor,
dentist, getting medical supplies, pet
emergencies or needs.



Get some fresh air. Take a walk with
your family, run or bike the GreenBelt,
play in your yard, walk your dog.



Go to work if employed by an essential
business or work outside of the county.
A pass or permit is not required.

WHAT'S ESSENTIAL?

Not sure if your employer is considered
essential or not? Ask your supervisor or
business' owner.

If your employer isn't sure, they can refer to
the **US. Department of Homeland Security.**

*The US Department of Homeland Security
determines Essential Business and Infrastructure.
This includes but is not limited to grocery stores,
convenience stores, gas stations, hardware
stores, department stores, building supply stores,
hospitals, doctors' offices, public works, first
responders, law enforcement, newspaper and
media, banks/financial institutions, maintenance
services, taxis, legal services, mail services. Refer
to the resolution for those included in this order.*

STAY AT HOME, DO NOT



Run **non-essential errands** for items or
services that can wait.



Go to **parks or playgrounds, gyms, salons,
non-essential trips, others' homes.**



If sick or at high risk, **stay home except
to seek medical care.**
