

NOTICE OF PROPERTY TAX INCREASE

The Carroll County Board of Education has tentatively adopted a millage rate which will require an increase in property taxes by 2.89 percent. Continuing the current millage rate over the rollback millage rate would allow the Board to provide virtual learning opportunities and enhanced school cleaning and disinfecting protocols.

All concerned citizens are invited to the public hearing on this tax increase to be held at the Carroll County Board of Education Board Room, 164 Independence Drive, Carrollton, Georgia 30116 on Monday, July 27, 2020 at 5:30 p.m. Times and places of additional public hearings on this tax increase are at the Carroll County Board of Education Board Room, 164 Independence Drive, Carrollton, GA 30116 on Monday, August 17, 2020 at 5:30 p.m. and Thursday, August 20, 2020 at 6:30 p.m.

This tentative increase will result in a millage rate of 17.998 mills, an increase of 0.505 mills. Without this tentative tax increase, the millage rate will be no more than 17.493 mills. The proposed tax increase for a home with a fair market value of \$175,000 is approximately \$33.33 and the proposed tax increase for non-homestead property with a fair market value of \$125,000 is approximately \$25.25.
