

NOTICE OF PROPERTY TAX INCREASE

The Carroll County Board of Education has tentatively adopted a millage rate which will require an increase in property taxes by 3.81 percent. Continuing the current millage rate over the rollback millage rate would allow the Board to provide enhanced student learning opportunities and invest in instructional personnel.

All concerned citizens are invited to the public hearing on this tax increase to be held at the Carroll County Board of Education Board Room, 164 Independence Drive, Carrollton, Georgia 30116 on Wednesday, August 4, 2021 at 12:00 p.m. Times and places of additional public hearings on this tax increase are at the Carroll County Board of Education Board Room, 164 Independence Drive, Carrollton, GA 30116 on Monday, August 16, 2021 at 5:30 p.m. and at the Carroll County Board of Education Performing Arts Center, 775 Old Newnan Road, Carrollton, GA 30116 on Thursday, August 19, 2021 at 6:30 p.m.

This tentative increase will result in a millage rate of 17.998 mills, an increase of 0.661 mills. Without this tentative tax increase, the millage rate will be no more than 17.337 mills. The proposed tax increase for a home with a fair market value of \$200,000 is approximately \$50.24 and the proposed tax increase for non-homestead property with a fair market value of \$150,000 is approximately \$39.66.
